#### **Company Highlights**

- China Fashion Holdings Ltd announced that the group had negotiated with the developer and the developer has agreed to refund the deposit of RMB6, 150,000 for the purchase of office unit in Hangzhou, Zhejiang Province, PRC. Up to present, the Group has received RMB2.55 million as part of the deposit refunded by the developer. The balance of the deposit is expected to be refunded soon.
- Enporis Greenz Ltd announced that SGX-ST has informed the company that it is unable to approve the company's application for extension of time to acquire a new business to satisfy the listing requirements under Rule 1018 of the Listing Manual. SGX-ST has further informed the company that the company shares will be allowed to continue to be traded until 31 July 2009, after which it will be suspended. Therefrom, the company is to take necessary steps to distribute and return cash to shareholders in accordance to Rule 1309 of the Listing Manual. After completion of the above, SGX-ST will proceed to delist the company.
- Singapore Exchange Ltd announced that they have inked their co-operation with Oslo Bors ASA with the signing of Memorandum of Understanding to facilitate the process of secondary listing of companies on each other's exchange. The dual listing framework will allow companies to diversify their shareholder base, build their profile and have an additional fund raising venue. The co-operation will begin with companies in the energy, offshore and shipping sectors which are key sectors common to both exchanges.
- ST Engineering announced that its aerospace arm, ST Aerospace has signed a component support programme worth US\$ 32.5M (about S\$47.3m) with Icelandic operator, Primera Air. The programme is for the maintenance, repair and overhaul (MRO) of its landing gears over five years and an eight-year comprehensive component Maintenance-By-the-Hour programme that includes parts exchange, MRO, component engineering services and logistics. These contracts are not expected to have any material impact on the consolidated net tangible assets per share and earnings per share of ST Engineering for the current financial year.
- **Top Global Ltd** announced that the company has increased its investment in the capital of its wholly-owned subsidiary, Top Global Enterprises Pte Ltd, from S\$3,024,887 to S\$3,314,887 by subscribing for an additional 290,000 shares in cash. The additional investment is to strengthen the capital base of Top Global Enterprises and to finance its working capital requirements.

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#### **Local and Regional Markets Headline**

**Japan's** Nikkei average fell 2.4 per cent to a six-week closing low on Wednesday, hurt by an unexpected slide in domestic machinery orders and as the yen rose to seven-week highs against the dollar on talk of more stimulus for the US economy. The benchmark Nikkei fell 227.04 points to 9,420.75. The broader Topix dropped 2.3 per cent to 888.54.

**Hong Kong** shares dropped 0.8 per cent in a third straight losing session yesterday, as talk swirled of the need for a second round of stimulus spending in the United States and a likely tightening of China's easy monetary policies. The benchmark Hang Seng Index finished down 141.20 points at a two-week low of 17,721.07.

**Malaysian** shares were flat on Wednesday due to mild profit-taking on selected blue chips. The FTSE Bursa Malaysia Kuala Lumpur Composite Index lost 0.89 point, or 0.08 per cent, to close at 1,065.47. Losers outnumbered gainers 336 to 188.

**Singapore** shares closed 0.55 per cent lower yesterday, joining other regional bourses in a fall on concerns over the prospects for an economic recovery. The blue-chip Straits Times Index fell 12.49 points to 2,259.77 on volume of 1.63 billion shares worth \$1.59 billion (US\$1.1 billion).

#### **US Market News**

Stocks finished mostly lower after zigzagging for much of the day Wednesday. A mixed outlook on the economy from the International Monetary Fund and falling commodity prices added to the downbeat mood.

IMF said it expects the world economy to shrink by 1.4 percent in 2009, slightly worse than its earlier estimate of 1.3 percent. Meanwhile, oil prices fell for a sixth straight day, dropping \$2.79 to settle at \$60.14 a barrel, tumbling sharply from an eight-month high of \$73 in just one week.

Stocks drew some support from a strong auction of 10-year Treasury notes. That helped allay one of the market's recent worries, that the government would have trouble finding enough buyers for the massive amount of debt it's issuing. But investors also flocked to the safety of government debt because they are worried about the economy.

The Dow Jones industrials rose 14.81, or 0.2 percent, to 8,178.41. The broader Standard & Poor's 500 index fell 1.47, or 0.2 percent, to 879.56 and the Nasdaq composite index rose 1.00, or 0.1 percent, to 1,747.17.
