Company Highlights

- BH Global Marine announced that for the second quarter ended 30 June 2009 ("2QFY09"), revenue has slipped by 4% to S\$26.1 million, mainly due to the drop in average selling price of marine cables and accessories as a result of lower copper price (main component of cables) and a stronger USD. In terms of profitability, gross profit dropped by 9% from S\$10.3 million in 2QFY08 to S\$9.3 million in 2QFY09 which was in line with the lower revenue as well as the lower gross margin. The gross margin remained healthy at 36%. Net profit attributable to shareholders decreased by 30% to S\$4.0 million, representing a net margin of 15%.
- **Singapore Airlines** in reporting its operating results, stated that system wide passenger carriage recorded a year-on-year decline of 18.2%, which outpaced the reduction in capacity of 14.4%. Passenger load factor declined 3.5 percentage points to 75.7%. The number of passengers carried decreased 19.2% over the same month last year to 1.3 million. Traffic demand continues to be soft, impacted by the global economic slowdown and uncertainty over the spread of Influenza A
- Luzhou Bio-Chem Technology Limited announced that it is expected to report net losses for the second quarter ("2QFY09") and 1HFY09 of the financial year ending 31 December 2009. The net loss for 2QFY09 which has resulted in a net loss for 1HFY09 was mainly due to the cost of main raw material (corn) rising faster than main product selling prices.
- Ramba Energy Limited issued a profit warning regarding the financial results of the Company and its subsidiaries for the first half year ending 30 June 2009. The Group's net financial result for 1HFY2009 will continue to be affected by the slowdown in sales due to the global financial crisis.
- Straits Asia Resources Limited announced that it has received notice of exercise of 10 million warrants into 10 million new Straits Asia shares at an exercise price of S\$1.095 per share. These warrants were part of the 35 million warrants that were issued to Standard Chartered Bank. 10 million New Shares were issued on 15 July 2009 and application has been made for the listing of and quotation for the New Shares on the Main Board of the SGX-ST.

Morning Note

Local and Regional Markets Headline

Japan's Nikkei average was flat on on Wednesday, giving up earlier gains made on upbeat results from Goldman Sachs and Intel after investors grew cautious ahead of more earnings in the United States and Japan. The benchmark Nikkei edged up 7.44 points to 9,269.25, after rising as much as 0.8 per cent at one stage. It fell to an eight-week low of 9,050.33 on Monday after climbing to a six-month high of 10,170.82 in mid-June. The broader Topix fell 0.3 per cent to 866.37

Hong Kong share prices closed 2.09 per cent higher on Wednesday, tracking gains on Wall Street and regional bourses. The benchmark Hang Seng Index ended up 372.93 points at 18,258.66. Turnover was HK\$60.69 billion (US\$7.78 billion)

Malaysian shares closed up 1.63 per cent on Wednesday due to strong gains in banking, plantation and technology stocks. The Kuala Lumpur Composite Index gained 17.61 points to 1,097.24. Gainers outpaced losers 574 to 174.

Singapore shares closed 3.41 per cent higher on Wednesday, mirroring gains in regional markets following better-than-expected earnings at US financial giant Goldman Sachs. The blue-chip Straits Times Index (STI) advanced 78.87 points to 2,389.42. Volume totalled 1.79 billion shares worth \$1.67 billion (US\$1.15 billion) and there were 427 rising issues, 116 losers while 708 issues were even.

US Market News

U.S. stocks jumped on Wednesday with the S&P 500 racking up its three best days since March, sparked by results from bellwether Intel Corp that lifted hopes for a rebound in technology spending and improved corporate profitability.

The broad S&P 500 has gained 6.1 percent so far this week as companies, including Intel and Goldman Sachs Group posted much better-than-expected results. It is the biggest three-day gain since the three major U.S. stock indexes began a rebound from 12-year lows in early March.

The Dow Jones industrial average rose 256.72 points, or 3.07 percent, to 8,616.21. The Standard & Poor's 500 Index .SPX gained 26.84 points, or 2.96 percent, to 932.68, its best gain in nearly two months and putting it solidly back into the black for the year. The Nasdaq Composite Index jumped 63.17 points, or 3.51 percent, to 1.862.90.
