Company Highlights

- Cambridge Industrial Trust announced that it is proposing to carry out a private placement of such number of new units in CIT at an issue price of S\$0.392 per Placement Unit so as to enable the Manager to raise gross proceeds of up to S\$28.0 million.
- See Hup Seng Limited announced that the Company is proposing a renounceable non-underwritten rights issue of up to 178,128,050 warrants at an issue price of S\$0.01 for each Warrant, each Warrant carrying the right to subscribe for one new ordinary share in the capital of the Company at an exercise price of S\$0.23 for each New Share, on the basis of one (1) Warrant for every two (2) existing ordinary shares in the capital of the Company held by Entitled Shareholders.
- SIA Engineering Co Ltd announced results for quarter ended 30 June 2009. Revenue declined \$6.0 million or 2.4% to \$244.2 million mainly due to lower airframe maintenance and component overhaul work. The Group recorded a profit attributable to equity holders of \$45.1 million, a decrease of \$13.6 million or 23.2% from the same quarter last year.
- Fuxing China Group Limited announced that the Group expects to register a significantly lower net profit for the second quarter ended 30 June 2009 ("2QFY2009") compared to the previous corresponding period. Demand for zipper and zipper products remains weak as disclosed in the Group's last results announcement on 14 May 2009. Coupled with intense competition which had lowered the average selling price of the Group's products, these factors have contributed a decrease in revenue of the Group's Zipper Segment for 2QFY2009 compared to the previous corresponding period, despite an increase in orders for 2QFY2009 compared to 1QFY2009.
- SAT Services Ltd announced results for quarter ended 30 June 2009. Group revenue rose 44% (+\$107.7 million) to \$351.7 million. The growth came mainly from the addition of Singapore Food Industries (SFI), which contributed \$132.9 million to Group revenue. The quarter saw lower aviation revenue, which fell 12%, in tandem with the weak aviation industry. Group operating profit increased 14% (+\$5.5 million) to \$43.7 million. Group profit before tax grew 17% (+\$7.7 million) to \$51.8 million while net profit attributable to equity holders increased 17% (+\$5.9 million) to \$40.4 million.
- **GMG Global Ltd** announced that it proposes to undertake a fully-underwritten renounceable rights issue to raise gross proceeds of approximately S\$100.0 million. Pursuant to the Rights Issue, 1,818,544,446 new ordinary shares in the capital of the Company at an issue price of S\$0.055 per Rights Share, will be offered at the ratio of nine (9) Rights Shares for every ten (10) existing ordinary shares in the capital of the Company held by Shareholders.



• Biosensors International Group, Ltd. results for its first quarter of fiscal year 2010 which ended 30 June 2009. Biosensors reported product revenues of US\$22.4 million, a 31% increase over the US\$17.1 million reported in the first quarter of fiscal year 2009. Licensing revenue in 1Q FY10 was US\$1.4 million, compared to US\$41.0 million for 1Q FY09, which included a one-time US\$40.0 million payment received from Terumo Corporation for a modification of an existing licensing agreement between Biosensors Europe and Terumo. Excluding this one-time nonrecurring payment, total revenue for 1Q FY10 grew from US\$18.0 million to US\$23.8 million, or 32%, over 1Q FY09. For 1Q FY10, the Group reported a net profit of US\$4.2 million compared to net earnings of US\$16.5 million prior year's corresponding period.

- **Boustead Singapore Limited** announced that its Energy-Related Engineering Division has secured contracts totalling S\$27 million from the global oil & gas industries. The latest contracts involve the design, process engineering and construction of key process equipment for large refineries and gas processing plants located in Algeria, Australia, Canada and Saudi Arabia.
- Oceanus Group Limited announced results for the quarter ended 30 June 2009. Sales revenue declined 13.1 % from RMB130.8 million to RMB73.5 million. Net profit attributable to shareholder is RMB79.5 million compared to a net loss of RMB36.6 million in the previous year.
- **OKP Holdings Limited** announced results for the quarter ended 30 June 2009. Revenue increased 42 % from \$22.4 million in the same period last year to \$31.9 million. Net profit attributable to shareholder increased 91.1% from \$1.9 million to \$3.6 million.
- Fragrance Group Limited announced that its subsidiary, Fragrance Realty Pte Ltd has acquired the property at Telok Kurau Road at the purchase consideration of S\$11,450,000.00. The development land has a land area of 1,520.9 sq meters. It is zoned 'Residential' and has a freehold tenure with the maximum plot ratio of 1.4. Subject to the Company obtaining all the necessary approvals from the relevant authorities, it intends to develop the development land into a residential apartment building. The costs of the above acquistion and development will be financed by internal funds and bank borrowings.
- **Europtronic Group Limited** announced results for the quarter ended 30 June 2009. Revenue decreased 43 % from \$21.7 million in the same period last year to \$12.4 million. Net loss attributable to shareholder is \$5.4 million compared to a net profit of \$50,000 in the same period last year.

Local and Regional Markets Headline

Singapore shares closed 1.71 per cent higher on Monday, mirroring gains in regional markets amid hopes of an economic rebound globally, dealers said. The blue-chip Straits Times Index was 43.23 points firmer at 2,576.66.

Hong Kong share prices closed 1.35 per cent higher on Monday, bolstered by gains in regional bourses, dealers said. The benchmark Hang Seng Index closed up 268.83 points at 20,251.62.

Japan's Nikkei average rose 1.5 per cent on Monday, gaining for a ninth straight day, on growing hopes for better-than-expected Japanese corporate earnings and an economic recovery, with top brokerage Nomura Ho The benchmark Nikkei gained 144.11 points to 10,088.66, its highest close since June 12 and booking its longest run of gains since 1988. It briefly touched 10,179.59, its highest level in nine months. The broader Topix rose 0.9 per cent to 928.26.

Malaysian shares closed flat on Monday amid a little buying interest from local funds, dealers said. The Kuala Lumpur Composite Index edged up 0.55 points, or 0.05 per cent, to 1,156.43. Gainers outnumbered losers 455 to 216.

US Market News

Stocks rose slightly on Monday in a late rally as investors rotated into financial shares, which had lagged in the recent two-week run-up.

Upbeat data on new home sales underpinned financial stocks, the session's strongest sector, and prompted investors to snap up the shares of several regional banks, which had been among the worst hit by credit losses tied to a weak housing market.

The Dow Jones US home construction index shot up 4.3 per cent after data showed US new home sales posted their biggest monthly gain in eight years in June, suggesting the housing market may be starting to recover from its worst slump since the Great Depression of the 1930s.

The Dow Jones industrial average rose 15.27 points, or 0.17 per cent, to close at 9,108.51. The Standard & Poor's 500 Index gained 2.92 points, or 0.30 per cent, to 982.18. The Nasdaq Composite Index added 1.93 points, or 0.10 per cent, to end at 1,967.89.
