Company Highlights

China XLX Fertiliser Ltd announce that the Company is contemplating the possibility of seeking a dual primary listing of the Shares on the main board of the SEHK. The directors of the Company are of the view that it is desirable and beneficial for the Company to have dual primary listing status in both Singapore and Hong Kong so that the Company can have ready access to these different equity markets in Asia Pacific region when the opportunity arises. The dual primary listing of the Shares in Hong Kong is in line with the Group's focus on its business operations in the People's Republic of China, which is important for the Group's long term growth and development. As at the date of this announcement, no application has been made to the SEHK for the listing of, and permission to deal in, the Shares, on the main board of the SEHK.

Tat Hong Holdings Ltd announced that the Company has disposed its 45% interest in KTH Mining Engineering Pte Ltd Kok Tong Construction Pte Ltd. The Company has received approximately SGD1,099 million (the "Consideration") for its 45% stake in KTHME. The valuation was arrived at on a willing-buyer, willing-seller basis. The Disposal is not expected to have any material impact to the Group's financial statements in FY10. The proceeds from the sale in this investment is SGD1.099million. The gain from the disposal of the investment is approximately SGD863,786 and it will be used for the Group's working capital.

ST Engineering announced that its electronics arm, ST Electronics, has won its sixth Mass Rapid Transit (MRT) project in Guangzhou, China. The Guangzhou-Foshan Line (GFL) contract worth RMB53.6m (approximately S\$11.7m) requires the provision of Platform Screen Doors (PSD) for the GFL which will run 32.3km from Kuiqi Station in Foshan, to Lijiao station in Guangzhou, in the Guangdong province. The contract is jointly awarded by Guangzhou Metro Corporation and Foshan Metro Corporation. Work commences immediately and is expected to be completed by the second half of 2010.

Fastech Synergy Ltd announced results for the quarter ended 30 June 2009. Revenue for the second quarter was US\$1.01 million compared with US\$3.10 million for the second quarter 2008. The company achieved a zero net profit compared to a net loss of US\$1,000 for the second quarter 2008.

BP Batteries International Limited announced results for the quarter ended 30 June 2009. Turnover for the three months ended 30 June 2009 was S\$187.2 million, a decrease of 15.7% over the corresponding period last year. Profit after tax attributable to equity holders was S\$10.7 million, compared to S\$0.1 million for the corresponding quarter last year.

JEL Corporation (Holdings) Ltd. ("JELCorp"), announced today that JEL Corporation (Far East) Pte Ltd, a wholly-owned subsidiary, has been awarded exclusive distribution rights for the entire range of Photographic products from Tamrac, Inc. With the appointment, JELCorp will now distribute Tamrac diverse line of camera bags, camera cases, photo daypacks, convertible camera bags, photo backpacks for the Central Asian region, comprising of Kazakhstan, Uzbekistan, Kyrgyzstan, Turkmenistan, and Tajikistan.

STATS ChipPAC Ltd. announced results for second quarter 2009. Revenue for second quarter of 2009 decreased by 26.1% over the second quarter of 2008. Net income for second quarter of 2009 was \$2.2 million compared to net income of \$22.1 million in the second quarter of 2008.



Fortune Real Estate Investment Trust announced results for the half year ended 30 June 2009. The total revenue rose 8.2% to HK\$334 million from HK\$309 million in the same period in 2008. Income available for distribution rose 7.1% to HK\$162 million from HK\$151 million last year. DPU for 1H09 was 19.60 Hong Kong cents, an increase of 5.9% from a year ago.

Pteris Global Ltd announced that it has been awarded a contract of SGD 17 million to design and build the Baggage Handling System for Queen Alia International Airport in Amman, Jordan.

Westcomb Financial Group Limited announced results for the half year ended 30 June 2009. Revenue from continuing operations decreased by S\$4.00 million or 86.4% from S\$4.63 million for the half year ended 30 June 2008 to S\$0.63 million for the half year ended 30 June 2009. The group registered a net loss attributable to shareholder of S\$1.58 million compared to net gain of \$0.43 million the previous year.

F&N Limited announced, that its subsidiary, Frasers Centrepoint Limited ("FCL"), has through its wholly-owned subsidiary, FCL China Development Pte Ltd, entered into a conditional sale and purchase agreement for the sale of its entire 100% shareholding interest in Metro Charm Holdings Limited, a company incorporated in Hong Kong. The consideration for the sale is approximately S\$200.7 million and was arrived at after negotiations on a willing buyer and willing seller basis.

Local and Regional Markets Headline

Singapore shares closed higher on Tuesday with the blue-chip Straits Times Index up 47.38 points to 2,624.04. Volume was 3.27 billion shares worth \$2.48 billion. Gainers led losers 408 to 170.

Malaysian shares closed up 1.38 per cent on Tuesday in line with regional gains, dealers said. The Kuala Lumpur Composite Index (KLCI) gained 15.95 points to 1,172.38. Gainers outpaced losers 491 to 194.

Hong Kong share prices closed 1.84 per cent higher on Tuesday, supported by strong liquidity, dealers said. The benchmark Hang Seng Index ended up 372.92 points at 20,624.54. Turnover was HK\$84.85 billion (US\$10.88 billion).

Japan's Nikkei share average edged lower to break a nine-day rising streak, as stocks that had led the strong runup such as Advantest Corp fell amid concern about the rapid pace of the rally. The benchmark Nikkei edged down 1.40 points to 10,087.26. It had climbed nine straight days by Monday, its longest run of gains since 1988. The broader Topix rose 0.2 per cent to 930.13.

US Market News

The Dow and the S&P 500 dipped on Tuesday, recovering from earlier declines, as investors shrugged off weak consumer confidence data and focused on positive earnings reports.

The US consumer confidence index declined more than expected in July, a second consecutive monthly fall, as a sluggish labour market continued to worry consumers, the Conference Board said.

Strong earnings have given a second wind to a stock market rally that wilted in June after a 40 per cent gain in the S&P 500 from its 12-year closing low in March.

The Dow Jones industrial average shed 11.79 points, or 0.13 per cent, to 9,096.72. The Standard & Poor's 500 Index dropped 2.56 points, or 0.26 per cent, to 979.62.

But the Nasdag Composite Index gained 7.62 points, or 0.39 per cent, to 1,975.51.
