#### **Technical**

On Monday (28 Sept 09), Asian equities posted a down day. We would like to see recently breached support levels to turn into resistance and trade off them. The inability to trade higher would indicate a higher chance of reversal. If the STI can trade below 2615 in this manner, it would bias short term momentum to the downside. Until support turns into resistance, our bias continues to lie with the trend.

### **Company Highlights**

- OKP Holdings Limited (OKP) has taken a first step to grow its external wing, in its bid to take on larger projects overseas. It announced today that it has entered into a Joint Venture (JV) Agreement with CIF Singapore Pte. Ltd. (CIF) through its wholly-owned subsidiary, OKP Technical Management Pte. Ltd., to undertake overseas projects. Singapore-incorporated CIF is a wholly-owned subsidiary of China Sonangol International (S) Pte. Ltd. (CSIS), which is in turn a subsidiary of China Sonangol International Limited (CSIL), an overseas conglomerate engaged in oil, gas, and minerals investment and explorations, crude oil supply and national infrastructure construction projects. The company has a strong market presence in Africa where it has been involved in major urban development projects for many years.
- Midas Holdings Limited is pleased to announce that the Hangzhou Metro Co., Ltd has awarded a RMB1.76 billion contract to its joint venture company, Nanjing SR Puzhen Rail Transport Co., Ltd, to supply 48 metro train sets, totalling 288 train cars for the Hangzhou Metro Line 1 Project. NPRT has an estimated 63% share of this contract. Delivery of the 288 train cars is expected to commence over the period from May 2011 to August 2013. As such this contract will have a positive impact on the financial results for the financial years ending from 2011 to 2013; and is not expected to have a material impact on the Group's financial results for the current financial year ending December 31, 2009.
- Mainboard-listed United Envirotech Ltd. is pleased to announce that it has secured a contract of RMB245 million to build and operate a 200,000 m3 per day drinking supply and wastewater treatment plant under a Build-Operate-Transfer (BOT) arrangement in Liaoyang City, Liaoning Province, PRC for a concessionary period of 30 years. The project is expected to bring in an estimated revenue of RMB1.4 billion over the concession period.

### **Local and Regional Markets Headline**

The Government of Singapore Investment Corp (GIC) said yesterday that an 'exceptional' decision to slash its exposure to stocks from mid-2007 shielded its vast portfolio from the worst of the financial crisis, though it still sustained heavy losses. That was the only time in GIC's history since its inception in 1981 that it attempted to time the market, GIC deputy chairman Tony Tan said. GIC's portfolio, comprising 'well over' US\$100 billion of Singapore's foreign reserves, slumped by more than 20 per cent in its latest financial year to end- March, in Singapore dollar terms, he said. It has since recovered more than half the losses as global stock markets rebounded, he added. The sharp decline over the year to March 31 dragged down its average annual return over a rolling 20-year period to 4.4 per cent, in Singapore dollar terms, from 5.8 per cent a year earlier.

THE newly installed Japanese government was faced with its first major economic challenge yesterday as the yen surged to an eight-month high against the US dollar, causing Finance Minister Hirohisa Fujii to backtrack on his previous insistence that monetary authorities will not intervene to stem the sudden surge. Yen strength or endaka could kill off Japan's incipient export recovery and, allied with proposed government wage and welfare reforms, could raise business costs and force more firms to shift production offshore, analysts said. Propelled by a combination of corporate repatriation of profits, market concerns about the US dollar and a resumption of yen 'carry trades', the yen surged to an eight-month high of 88.23 against the US dollar in Tokyo yesterday.

#### **US Market News**

U.S. stocks rallied on Monday, snapping a three-day losing streak, as a spurt of corporate takeovers in the technology and health-care sectors fueled optimism about share values. Mergers and acquisitions are typically viewed as bullish as it suggests companies are more optimistic about the business outlook.

A number of deals were announced and investors bet more could follow. Xerox Corp agreed to buy Affiliated Computer Services Inc, and Abbott Laboratories said it would pay \$6.6 billion for Solvay's drug unit. The Dow Jones industrial average rose 124.17 points, or 1.28 percent, to end at 9,789.36. The Standard & Poor's 500 Index gained 18.60 points, or 1.78 percent, to 1,062.98. The Nasdaq Composite Index shot up 39.82 points, or 1.90 percent, to 2,130.74.
